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How to Submit a VRC Digital Engineering Notebook

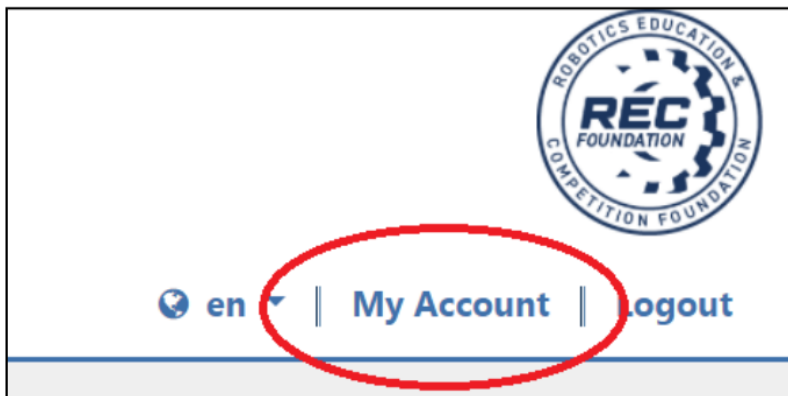
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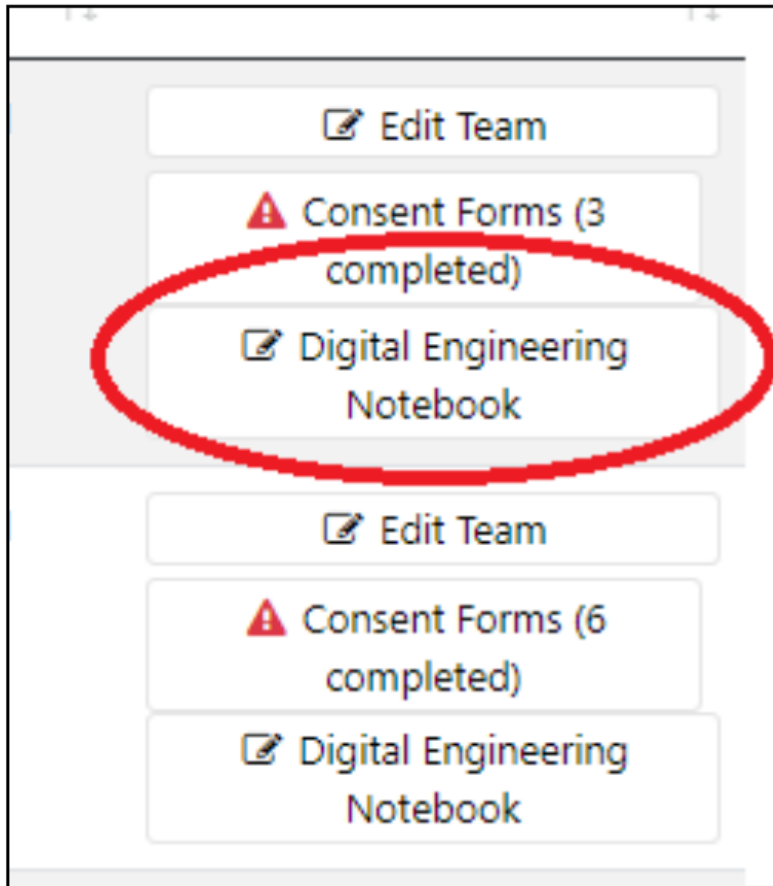
Some tournaments may request that you submit a digital copy of your engineering notebook, regardless of whether it was natively created as a digital or paper notebook. Notebooks are submitted through the team's [RobotEvents.com](#) logins by one of the team's registered contacts, and may be to either a native digital format or a scanned PDF copy of a paper notebook.

For Team Contacts

Step 1: Go to [RobotEvents.com](#), Login, and click on “My Account” in the upper right corner.



Step 2: Immediately on your dashboard, you will see all of the teams registered to your RobotEvents account this season, and on the right-hand side is a link to a Digital Engineering Notebook.



Step 3: Once you have selected a team, enter the **full URL** to the team's engineering notebook. Ensure sharing settings do not require login credentials to view.

Notebook Link

For each event the team is registered for this season, the Event Partner and Judge Advisor will have access to the team's Digital Engineering Notebook link. Ensure the link is "open" and does not require a password or access rights.

The Digital Engineering Notebook must be accessible as a single link. That is, the entire notebook should be accessible by a single click on the single link provided. Multiple links for "volumes" of a single notebook are not acceptable.

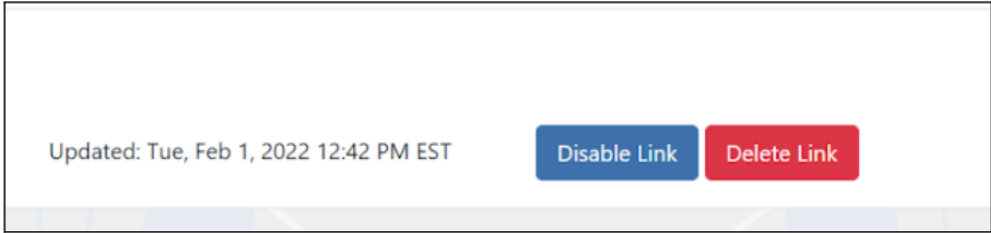
Link to Digital Engineering Notebook:

If you enter a link that requires login credentials to view, you will get the error seen below. You must modify the sharing settings of your link to correct the error message.

Step 4: If the link goes through, you will see the link appear below. This means your notebook link is in the system, and you should be done!



Options to disable or delete the link appear after the link has been posted. A team may wish to disable the link after the season is over.
